How it works

1 Order a drum

Fill out the form:

Our shipping company will deliver the drum to you within a few working days.

2 Collect scrap metal

Throw monolithic carbide tools into the drum.

Indexable inserts are permitted, but steel increases the sorting effort and is not remunerated.

3 Arrange pick-up

Is your drum full? Then seal it and arrange for pick-up by contacting your person of contact by telephone, email or even through your preferred shipping company.

4 Receive credit note

Your credit note will be automatically applied to one of your next orders. We will also provide you with transparent documentation of the drum's contents.







FAQs

1. How does the bonus model work?

We recycle your carbide scrap and you receive the scrap price plus a 3% credit. For each additional field – new tools, regrind service, tool management – another 3% is added. If you cover all four fields, you receive an additional 3% = up to 15% credit note.

2. What requirements do I have to meet for the bonus model?

- Carbide recycling at Gühring is a prerequisite.
- Purchase of new tools from Gühring in the last 12 months.
- Tool refurbishment at Gühring within the last 12 months.
- You use Gühring Tool Management Software (GTMS) and/or Gühring dispensing systems.

3. How do I get a Gühring steel drum to collect the scrap?

Fill out the attached form – digitally or on paper – and send it to your personal contact or to recycling@guehring.de.

4. What are the costs for the steel drum?

The steel drum is provided to you for free on loan. Delivery of the drum is also free.

5. How much does it cost to have my drum collected when it's full?

The collection costs depend on the size of your drum, how much scrap you have collected and where we collect the drum from. The costs are usually between €65 and €135 per collection. We would be happy to provide you with a non-binding quote.

6. Where do I send the drum if I arrange the collection myself?

7. How do I get a new drum once the old one has been collected?

As soon as we have collected the full drum from you, you will automatically receive a new, empty drum for free within a few working days.

9. How does the credit note work?

After receiving your carbide scrap, we sort it and create a sorting report. We then credit the determined scrap value, including any bonus, to your debtor account. This process usually takes 4–6 weeks. The credit note cannot be paid out.

10. How does carbide recycling work at Gühring?

Gühring recycles the carbide in its own recycling plants in Berlin and Bavaria using the zinc recycling process.
